EMLI Bwaise Facility Volunteer/Internship Program

The Internship Program is open to ALL. The goal of this Internship Program is to offer successful applicants an opportunity to improve their skills as well as the experience of working in a Sub-Saharan African environment.

To be eligible for the Internship Program, applicants must possess an ordinary level certificate of education or its equivalent and willing to volunteer.

This Program typically seeks applicants in the following fields: economics, human development (public health, education, population), social science (anthropology, sociology), agriculture, environment, as well as other related fields.

Fluency in English is required. Prior relevant work experience, computing skills, as well as knowledge of languages such as French, Swahili, and native languages are advantageous.

General terms and conditions

Immediate family members of EMLI Bwaise Facility staff are not eligible to apply.

Upon selection for an internship placement an 'Internship Agreement' is forwarded to the confirmed candidate for signature and returned prior to an agreed starting date;

The intern is required to keep confidential all information made known during his/her internship and may not publish any reports or papers on the basis of information obtained, except with the written authorization of the organization;

An intern undertakes to conduct himself/herself at all times in a manner compatible with his/her responsibilities as an intern.

Financial aspects, expenses and medical benefits

The Internship Programme operates on a non-remunerative basis. Costs and arrangements for travel, visas, accommodation and living expenses are the responsibility of the intern or his sponsoring institution or government.

EMLI Bwaise Facility accepts no responsibility for the medical insurance for the intern or for any costs arising from accidents and/or illness during the internship period.

EMLI Bwaise Facility is not responsible for any claims by an intern or third party in the case of loss or damage to property or death or personal injury as a result of actions or omissions on the part of the intern during the internship period.

Further career opportunities

The purpose of the Internship Programme is to complement an intern's studies, not to lead to further employment with the organization. An intern is not entitled to apply for a regular position or hold a consultancy or contractor agreement with the organization either during the internship, or within the following months.

Application

Applications should be forwarded to the Executive Director. Due to the high number of applications, only short listed and/or selected candidates will be contacted. Applications (in English) should include the following:

- Application letter
- Recent curriculum vitae (CV);
- A cover letter indicating the motivation and reason for an internship with EMLI Bwaise Facility as well as the preferred field of work.

EMLI Bwaise Facility Internship Program is offered during two terms:

• Term I (June-September)

The application period for Term I Program is **December 1 - January 31** each year.

Term II (December-March)

The application period for Term II Program is **September 1 - October 31** each year.

Applications submitted after the deadline are not considered.
